# Breakfast Meeting Held to Welcome Visiting Japanese Prime Minister Yasuo Fukuda


changes between the youth and friendship between our peoples contain the future of the relationship.

The ice-thawing visit remains fresh in my mind.



t the invitation of the CPAFFC, former US A President Jimmy Carter paid a visit to China from December 3 to 7, 2007. On December 5, Xi Jinping, member of the Standing Committee of the Political Bureau of the CPC Central Committee and the Secretariat of the CPC Central Committee, met with and entertained him and his party at the Great Hall of the People. Tang Jiaxuan, State Councillor; Xu Kuangdi, vice chairman of the National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC) and president of the China-US Peoples Friendship Association (CUSPFA); Li Xueju, minister of civil affairs; and Li Xiaolin, vice president of the CPAFFC, met with or entertained him on different occasions. Carter attended the meeting marking the 28th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between China and the United States and the "China Night" activity organized by the American National Geographic Society. He visited the China University of Political Science and Law and gave a speech to the teach-

ers and students.

#### Party and State Leaders Meeting with Jimmy Carter

When meeting with Jimmy Carter, Comrade Xi Jinping spoke highly of his contributions to the establishment of China-US diplomatic relations and the promotion of friendship between the two countries. Xi said, over the past 28 years since the establishment of diplomatic relations, thanks to concerted efforts by both sides, bilateral relations have made steady progress with common interests being expanded and fields of cooperation widened continuously. China is willing to work with the United States, strengthen dialogue, mutual trust and cooperation and properly handle differences and sensitive issues so as to continue to push forward China-US constructive and cooperative relations.

Tang Jiaxuan expressed appreciation of Carter's efforts to bring about the establishment of China-US diplomatic relations during his presidency and his continuous care about and support

The two sides

unanimously held that the similarity and complementariness between China and India in the field of health were a good foundation for the medical colleges of the two countries to carry out exchanges and cooperation in the future.

## Caring about Disadvantaged Groups

Both China and India are populous countries and have a vast number of disadvantaged people that need to be given

of China-US relations after leaving the office. Tang said, as the Chinese saying goes "When you drink the water, think of those who dug the well", the Chinese people will not forget Mr. Carter's important and valuable contributions to China-US relations.

Carter regarded it as the happiest thing in his life that during his presidency he promoted the establishment of US-China diplomatic relations and the U.S. explicitly recognized that there is only one China in the world and that Taiwan is part of China. He said, the establishment of US-China diplomatic relations in 1979 was a historic event

of world influence giving profound impact on the United States, China, Asia and the whole world. He believed, in spite of their different political systems, the two countries can get along well with mutual tolerance. He said that he had full confidence in the bright prospect of China's development and that he would continue to promote the development of bilateral relations.

## Meeting Marking the 28th Anniversary of China-US Diplomatic Relations

On the afternoon of December 5, the CPAFFC held a meeting marking the 28th anniversary of

special care. How to help them is of special significance for the two countries to maintain steady and rapid growth. For this reason, the CIJMM paid an official call on the Ministry of Health with the aim of knowing about China's three-tier rural health care network, rural medical facilities, training of rural medical workers and the new type cooperative medical care system in rural areas. treatment to the local people and home medical service to the farmers living in the out-of-the way places. They had discussions with the local doctors on some difficult cases of illness, imparted experiences in making diagnosis and giving treatment and donated medicine to the Tangxian County Hospital and the farmers who needed help. The CIJMM was warmly welcomed by the local people wherever they went.

the establishment of China-US diplomatic relations. Vice Chairman Xu Kuangdi, CPAFFC Vice President Li Xiaolin, former US President Jimmy Carter and US Ambassador to China Clark T. Randt, Jr. attended the meeting among more than 100 council members of the CUSPFA, scholars on China-US relations as well as students from universities in Beijing. Xu Kuangdi, Jimmy Carter and C. T. Randt, Jr. spoke on the occasion and Carter answered the questions raised by the participants.

In his speech, Xu Kuangdi said, the establishment of diplomatic relations between China and the United States, an important event that has great impact on the world and the future, is the result of concerted efforts made by both Chinese and American statesmen. The two countries should continue to strengthen dialogue, perseveringly carry out people-to-people exchanges and deepen mutual understanding and friendship be-

tween the two peoples.

In his speech, Carter for the first time revealed his personal diary from 1977 to 1979 about the tortuous course of the establishment of US-China diplomatic relations, including how he withstood the huge pressure from the Congress to have secret negotiations with Deng Xiaoping and other Chinese leaders on establishing diplomatic relations between the two countries, to sever diplomatic relations with Taiwan and recognize that Taiwan is a part of China and to finally bring about the establishment of US-China diplomatic relations. He also recalled with feelings Deng Xiaoping's visit to the United States and the profound friendship between them.

Carter expressed satisfaction with the visit and hoped that he would visit China again at the end of 2008 to attend a series of activities marking the 30th anniversary of the establishment of China-US diplomatic relations. □

# Fourth Meeting of China-Spain Forum Held in Madrid

hairman Hu Oili and Executive Chairman Chen Haosu of the Chinese Committee of the China-Spain Forum (CSF) led a Chinese delegation to attend the Fourth Meeting of the CSF in Madrid from November 27 to 28, 2007. The meeting with the theme of "Harmony, Development and Gaining Win-Win Results" was jointly sponsored by the CPAFFC, the CSF Chinese Committee, the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Spain China Council Foundation.

On November 27, the opening ceremony of the Fourth Meeting was held in Madrid, at which Chinese Vice Premier Hui Liangyu and Spanish Deputy Prime Minister Maria Teresa Fernandez de La Vega were present. In his speech Vice Premier Hui said, the establishment of the comprehensive strategic partnership between China and Spain in 2005 is an important milestone in the bilateral relations. Through the joint efforts of the two sides, China-Spain relations have entered into the best period of development. Vice Premier Hui put forward a five-point suggestion for comprehensively raising the level of China-Spain cooperation in all fields: 1. The two coun-

The two countries should continue to boost economic and trade cooperation, further broaden areas of cooperation, expand the scale of trade, strengthen mutual investment

and carry out close cooperation with enriched contents between enterprises. 3. The two countries should further expand culeducational tural and changes, increase contacts at all levels, enhance mutual understanding and push the bilateral substantial cooperation in the fields of culture, science, technology, education, sports, etc. to a higher level. 4. The two countries should continue to do a good job in holding the Year of Spain in China and the Chinese Art Festival in Spain, and take the opportunities of the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games, the World Exposition 2010 Shanghai and the Saragossa World Exposition to further strengthen exchanges and cooperation. 5. The two countries should give full play to the effective role of the CSF, improve its mechanism, and continue to explore new areas, new thinking and new ways for bilateral cooperation so as to make greater contributions to the China-Spain comprehensive strategic partnership.


Maria Teresa Fernandez de La Vega, Spanish first deputy prime minister, Hu Qili, chairman of the CSF Chinese Committee, Juan Antonio Samaranch, chairman of the CSF Spanish Committee, and Alberto Ruiz-Gallardon, mayor of Madrid, also spoke on the occasion. Over 500 Chinese and Spanish representatives of various circles were present at the opening ceremony. Spanish King Juan Carlos and Prime Minister Jose Luis Rodriguez Zapatero met with Vice Premier Hui Liangyu on separate occasions.

He Luli, vice chairperson of the Standing Committee of the Chinese National People's Congress, and Carmen Calvo, first vice president of the Spanish Congress of Deputies, attended the closing ceremony of the meeting and spoke on the occasion. Vice Chairperson He expressed her warm congratulations on the full success of the Fourth Meeting of the CSF and spoke highly of the positive role played by the CSF in promoting Sino-Spanish relations. said, through serious discussions in the past two days, representatives of the two sides exfully changed views and reached forward-looking consensus on the important topics including the current situation and existing problems in the bilateral cooperation in the fields of politics, economy, culture, sports, laws and between localities and cities, orientation of ioint efforts and planned goals. Chen Haosu said in his concluding speech, since its founding in 2003, the CSF has made progress in its work in three aspects: First, on the basis of governmental cooperation, the CSF has encouraged more nongovernmental organizations to participate in the China-Spain cooperation. At the Third China-Spain Business Summit and Economic Committee Meeting which were jointly held, the participants had in-depth discussions on financial reform and cooperation with the third market. The two sides signed 6 agreements on cooperation.

At the closing ceremony,

Chen Haosu, on behalf of the CPAFFC, conferred the honorary title of Friendship Ambassador upon Juan Antonio Samaranch in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the friendship between the Chinese and Spanish people. #### **Mutual Political Trust**




During its stay in India, the delegation had a working meeting with Dr. Karan Singh, president of

#### Unofficial Contact Promoted



t the invitation of the A CPAFFC, Paul Bell, president of the Australian Local Government Association (AL-GA), led a delegation composed of presidents of the branches of the ALGA to visit Beijing, Qingdao, Shenzhen and Guangzhou from December 1 to 12, 2007. Li Xiaolin, vice presithe CPAFFC, Wu Jingjian, vice mayor of Qingdao, Liao Junwen, vice chairman of the Shenzhen Municipal Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, and Tang Bingdeputy governor of Guangdong Province, met with the delegation on separate occasions. During its visit in China, the delegation paid an official

call on the Foreign Ministry, visited the Beijing Planning Exhibition Hall and some of the venues of the Olympic Games as well as enterprises in Qingdao, Shenzhen and Guangzhou.

## Speaking Highly of China's Social and Economic Progress

Most of the members of the delegation visited China for the first time. The booming social and economic development in the places they visited left a deep impression on them. President Bell said to CPAFFC Vice President Li Xiaolin that this was his first visit to Beijing where he saw cranes everywhere and was amazed at the vigorous construction. He said, China has a population of 1.3

billion; so one can well imagine what a heavy pressure the government is under. But the Chinese government has not only successfully solved the problem of letting people have adequate food and clothing, but also created conditions to raise the living standards of the people. Mayor Mike Gaffney from Tasmania said, he had visited Beijing ten years ago. During the ten years Beijing has experienced an earth-shaking change. Particularly the environment has been greatly improved. Streets have become cleaner and the sky bluer.

During the delegation's visit in Qingdao, Paul Bell said to Vice Mayor Wu Jingjian, Qingdao boasts not only a beautiful





natural harbour, but also rapid urbanization. The delegation was very much interested in the Qingdao Olympic Sailing Base, and the fine harbour in Qingdao was very much suited for holding sailing competitions.

The members of the delegation were very much impressed by Shenzhen's tremendous economic achievements, developing from a small fishermen's village to a modern international garden city in a short period of 30 years. Paul Bell said to Governor Deputy Tang Bingquan that it was thanks to the Chinese government's correct leadership that Guangzhou Shenzhou could have achieved such a rapid social and economic development.

During the visit, the members of the delegation asked questions about China's environmental protection, urban planning and the gap between the rich and the poor and got satisfactory answers during the meetings with the Chinese side.

## Praising the Smooth Development of Australia-China Relations

During his visit in China,

ALGA President Paul Bell said. Australia established since diplomatic relations with China in December 1972, bilateral relations have been developing smoothly. The two countries have carried out extensive exchanges and cooperation in various fields; particularly the cooperation in education and tourism has continued to expand. At present there are 90,000 Chinese students studying in Australia. In 2007 300,000 person/times of Chinese tourists visited Australia.

When visiting enterprises including the Haier Group in Oingdao and Huawei Technologies Co. Ltd in Shenzhen, the members of the delegation were amazed at the achievements in high technologies made by the Chinese enterprises, and got a better understanding about Chinese famous brands and more objective information of "China made" products. Bell said, the economic cooperation between the two countries is becoming increasingly close. China has Australia's become biggest trade partner. Chinese products are both good in quality and cheap in price. He hoped that in future Chinese products would have more share in the Australian market.

#### Promoting Exchanges and Cooperation between Local Governments

At the working meeting with the CPAFFC, the members of the delegation said, the exchanges and cooperation in various fields between the two countries have achieved notable results. Exchanges between the local governments and between the nongovernmental organizations of the two countries have been very active. Teresa Saenz, representative of the Andalucian Regional Government and director general of the Agency for International Economic Cooperation; Miguel Angel Serrano, director general of the Agency for Innovation and Development of Andalucia; Hu Qili, chairman of the Chinese Committee of the CSF, Chen Haosu, president of the CPAFFC; and Zheng Silin, executive vice president of the China Enterprise Confederation; attended the opening ceremony and spoke on the occasion.

In her speech, Teresa Saenz said, in the past 20 years the value of economic growth of the Andalucian Region has surpassed the average level of the EU and Spain. Andalucia attaches importance to the economic and trade cooperation with China. China is Spain's fourth largest import partner, while Spain ranks the 15th in China's foreign trade and Andalucia the 12th among its 17 regions.

Andalucia can supply China high quality products, good services and rich experience in regional management. She hoped that the two countries would take this seminar as an opportunity to make a good start for the economic cooperation between the localities.

In his speech Zheng Silin said, in carrying out economic and technological cooperation between the localities, the two countries should pay attention to the following aspects: 1. Each side should have a good understanding of the local economic features and investment policies of the other side, and select the places and projects for making investment that are good to the development of its own enterprises while meeting the other side's requirements. 2. He successively served as a leading official of the Health, Labour and Welfare Department of the Liberal Democratic Party and member of the Law Committee of the House of Representatives and since August 2007 as parliamentary secretary for health, labour and welfare. He is friendly to China and said once and again, that as a young politician he wished to make contributions to Japan-China friendship.

The CFTS was established in 1999 with the aim of helping the governments, enterprises, trade unions and citizens of Takatsuki and its neigbouring areas coexist harmoniously, constantly improving the people's living environment and livelihood and continuing to promote local political democracy and making contributions to the social development of the region.

Usuki Sensuke, head of the delegation and chairman of the Central Executive Committee of the Japan Panasonic Home Appliances and Lighting Alliance, is chairman of the Forum. Advisors to the Forum include mayor of Takatsuki, members of the House of Representatives from the Liberal Democratic Party, the Social Democratic Party and the Democratic Party, and chairman of the Board of Directors of the Japan Matsushita Electric Industrial Co., Ltd. The Forum has about

20,000 members in Japan and every year organizes goodwill delegations to visit China.

The aim of the delegation's visit to China was to learn about the preparations for the Beijing Olympic Games, the urban development plans, environmental protection, citizens' life as well as the present condition of the Japanese enterprises in Beijing, further promote exchanges and cooperation between Japan and China in various fields and push forward the cause of Japan-China friendship.

#### Vice Mayor of Beijing Meets with the Delegation

During his meeting with the delegation, Vice Mayor Ding Xiangyang, at the request of the Japanese guests, briefed them on Beijing's urban construction and environmental protection. He said, in the past more than ten years, Beijing has developed rapidly and maintained double-digit economic growth. Both the Chinese people and foreigners can feel these changes from which ordinary people have gained substantial benefits. But, along with the urban modernization, because of lack of experience, the problem of environmental pollution has cropped up and aroused more and more concern both at home and abroad. He told the guests that they came at the season when Beijing's air quality was the worst.

Ding said, Beijing is an international metropo-

lis where the 2008 Olympic Games will be held. So, the municipal government pays great attention to the environmental problem. In order to keep the municipal leaders informed of the Beijing's air quality and enhance their sense of urgency, tens of environment observation stations have been set up in the city's surrounding districts and counties. The collected data of the air quality is timely shown on the screen in the hall of the municipal government building every day. We are under great pressure when the capital's air quality is bad.

Ding continued, to improve the environment, the government has, in the past few years, spent 100 billion RMB yuan mainly on reducing pollutant emission and moving the enterprises that cause serious pollution out of Beijing. For example, the Capital Iron and Steel Company has reduced its annual steel output from 8 million tons to 4 million tons and its main production enterprises have been moved to Hebei Province. In addition, we are trying hard to use wind and geothermal energy. Through our efforts, people living in about 30 million square metres of housing will start to use geothermal energy in the near future. Meanwhile, we pay great attention to energy conservancy. For example, energy-saving lighting is recommended to the public. The air conditioned government offices, shops and enterprises' buildings are required to keep the temperature not below 26 degrees Celsius in summer. All lights in

the offices are required to be turned off when there is no one working there. We also pay attention to water conservancy. All units with feasible conditions are required to build water storage ponds. There is a water storage pond in the municipal government compound. Now pollution in Beijing has been reduced and environment improved.

Kenta Matsunami thanked Vice Mayor Ding for meeting with him in the midst of pressing affairs. He briefed about Japan's practice and experience in environmental protection and the work done by the CFTS for Japan-China friendship. When talking about Japan-China friendship, he said, "I am 36 years old and Vice Mayor Ding 48. We are young Japanese and Chinese politicians. We should work together to make greater contributions to Japan-China friendship and let the friendship between the people of our two countries last from generation to generation."

#### Wang Xiaoxian Recalls Friendship between Deng Xiaoping and Konosuke Matsushita

At the banquet in honour of the delegation, CJFA Vice President Wang Xiaoxian, on behalf of Chen Haosu and Luo Qin, CPAFFC president and secretary general, extended welcome to the delegation's visit to China. On learning that most of the members of the delegation were staffers of the Matsushita Electric Industrial Co., Ltd., she

said, the Matsushita Corporation is the first Japanese enterprise to invest in China at the beginning of China's reform and opening up, embodying China-Japan friendship.

She recalled with feelings Comrade Deng Xiaoping's meetings with Konosuke Matsushita. She said, in the autumn of 1978, to demonstrate that the Chinese Government attached great importance to the Sino-Japanese Peace and Friendship Treaty, the then Vice Premier Deng Xiaoping decided to attend the ceremony for exchange of instruments of ratification of the treaty and pay a visit to Japan. She served as the interpreter and accompanied Deng Xiaoping on that visit of historic significance. It was one of China's national leaders' first visit to Japan since the two countries normalized their diplomatic relations. Deng was accorded warm welcome and a grand reception by the Japanese leaders and people.

During his inspection tour in Osaka, Comrade Deng Xiaoping visited a factory of the Matsushita Electric Industrial Co., Ltd. Konosuke Matshshita, at the age of 83, known as the "god of business management", welcomed Deng outside the gate of the factory and showed him round the factory. After the visit Deng wrote: "China-Japan friendship has bright prospects" on the visitors' autograph album and said, we came here to meet you with an attitude of learning from you. In the past China

neither had external nor internal debts. We felt proud of it. In the future we want to modernize our country and are prepared to introduce foreign technologies and capital on the basis of self-reliance. Without electronic industry, modernization can not be realized. So I hope your electronic industry can be introduced into China. Konosuke Matsushita was very much interested in it, expressing his willingness to visit China. In June 1979, invited by the CJFA he paid a visit to China. Comrade Deng Xiaoping met with him happily and said to him: "We need to introduce advanced technologies to help upgrade our industries. Otherwise, our modernization would lag behind others." Matsushita said: "I am determined to help China modernize its electronic industry."

In 1980 Mr. Matsushita visited China again, beginning the Matsushita Electric Industrial Corporation's investment and setting up factories in China. At that time many foreign enterprises took a skeptical attitude towards China's reform and opening up. When they were taking a wait-and-see attitude, Matsushita resolutely made the decision to have cooperation with China. In 1987 with great support from the Chinese Government and the departments concerned, Beijing's first joint venture, the Beijing Matsushita Colour CRT Co., Ltd. (BMCC), was set up. Since then, great amounts of foreign capital have flown into

#### PLBC Works to Enhance China-Japan Friendship

The Japan Panasonic Home Appliances and Lighting Alliance led by Usuki Sensuke has more than 40 enterprises in Japan and many enterprises in other parts of the world including Japan-China joint ventures and enterprises of Japanese exclusive investment in Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou and Xian. The Panasonic Lighting (Beijing) Co., Ltd. (PLBC) that the delegation visited is one of them.

Now it has factory buildings with a space of 10,000 square metres and over 500 high-quality workers and staff. In 2005 it set up a branch in Langfang, Hebei Province, producing glasses used in making lamps.

The PLBC now has 4 fluorescent lamp production lines of world's advanced level with an annual production capacity of 32 million lamps. Its products are sold in China and also exported to Japan, Southeast Asia, Europe and the United States.

He said, recently they had developed environment-friendly products to support China's effort in environmental protection. These products of high quality, long service time, electricity saving and good luminance are popular with the Chinese customers, though their prices are 30% higher than those in the same category in the market.



Xinjiang, Gansu and other places of China. He entered Xinjiang from Central Asia, through the Hexi Corridor and reached Lanzhou, an important city of western China, and further along the route through Shaanxi, Henan, Shanxi and Hebei, arrived in Beijing. During his journey, Mannerheim made topographic surveys, drew maps and took notes of hydrometeorological data. Wherever he went, he made friends extensively with local officials of all levels, getting to know the local defense, economy and civil ad-

ministration, etc. He also specially visited leaders of ethnic groups and heads of tribes there, paying attention to the history, customs and habits of ethnic groups in the western region, leaving a great number of diaries, investigation reports and memoirs about his travel in China, a considerable amount of records of society of western China in late Qing Dynasty, and cultural relics of historical, geographical, social and humanistic values. He took about 1,300 photos along his journey through western China which are preserved in the National Museum of Finland. All the 60 pictures on display were carefully chosen out

The well-preserved photos with captions showed the folk customs and natural sceneries of the western regions 100 years ago from multiple perspectives. # Foreign Students in Tianjin Visit Elderly People's Home

On the afternoon of December 7, 2007, the Tianjin Municipal People's Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries (TMPAFFC) organized more than 20 Japanese and ROK teachers and students of Nankai University to visit the Tianjin Elderly People's Home.

The Tianjin Elderly People's Home, built in 1953 and covering an area of over 40 mu, is a comprehensive welfare institution for the elderly people which provides such services as accommodation, medical care, nursing, nutrition counseling, rehabilitation, education, recreation, deathbed care and train-

ing. In it there are a branch of the Tianjin Elderly People's University, the Tianjin Nurse Training School for Caring the Aged and a hospital for senile diseases with 500 beds. The Home mainly admits unsupported aged people, elderly people who pay for their own expenses and those who are critically ill needing deathbed care. People above 60 without infectious diseases or mental disorder can apply for admission.

There the foreign teachers and students learnt that the average age is 80 in the Home. There are two centenarians and 51 over 90. There are multi-

ple-bed, three-bed and double rooms, and one-room and double-room flats. The rooms are furnished and equipped with household appliances and the electronic paging system. The foreign students and teachers visited with interest the bedrooms, the flats, the canteen, the reading room, the recreation room, the clinic, etc. They brought the elderly fruits, had cordial chat with them and sang foreign folk songs for them. They learnt that the government provides or subsidizes the living and medical expenses and meticulous medical care for family members of revolutionary martyrs and unsupported

aged people.

When seeing the Chinese government provide such good living conditions and take good care of the elderly people who were living happily, the foreign teachers and students were greatly touched. maining years." A ROK student said: "Through this visit I have seen many warm and loving scenes, which have moved me greatly. The TMPAFFC, by organizing this activity, gave us a chance to know more deeply about Tianjin."

Before the visitors' departure, the elderly people presented the foreign visitors with their calligraphic works, paintings and handicrafts made by themselves. The elderly and the visi-

tors had pictures taken together and wished each other good health. The half-day visit made the students feel edified and happy and left a wonderful impression on them. They said that they would treasure the chance of studying in Tianjin and that they would study Chinese language and other subjects well so as to contribute their bit to the friendly exchanges and cooperation between their own countries and China.  $\Box$
